

Lethal Vodka Warning

Trading Standards Officers are urging Staffordshire residents to keep a look out for illicit 'Admiral' branded vodka following investigations undertaken in Tamworth.

Reports have been received from local Police officers who came into contact with highly intoxicated youngsters who had been drinking it. Enquiries reveal it originated from a storage unit that had been subject to a recent break-in. The vodka contains over 7 times the maximum permitted limit of methanol and is therefore a danger to public health. Officers fear that other bottles may be in circulation in Tamworth and beyond so have asked the public to remain vigilant.
